

MVMS Students and Cell Phones

At MVMS cell phones must be turned off (not silent or vibrate) for the ENTIRE school day. Students who choose to bring cell phones to school must keep them in their locker, zipped inside their backpack or tucked into their pocket. Students who choose to bring their cell phone to school need to show responsibility for understanding the school policy.



Students who use their cell phone or have their cell phone out during the school day violate this policy. Confiscated cell phones will be kept in the school safe until released to the student's parents.

→FIRST OFFENSE—Kept in safe until the end of the next school day, and then released to the parent.

→SECOND OFFENSE—Kept in the safe for 7 days, and released to the parent at the end of the 7th day.

→THIRD OFFENSE—Kept in the safe for 14 days, and released to the parent at the end of the 14th day.

Phones that are confiscated on a Friday, will be held in the office over the weekend.

Students are always permitted to use the office phone during recess, lunch and after school.

Students are not able to receive calls or text messages during the school day.

Students are not permitted to turn their cell phone on to check the time during the school day.
